
Sunday, October 23 New Member Sunday

Anne Thomas) as she affirms her faith on Confirmation Sunday. Confirmation at St. Stephen is called Emerge, a name that reflects how our 6th-8th graders are emerging as individuals and developing a worldview and sense of identity that extends beyond their nuclear family. During the course of Wednesday classes, students explore what it means to live out their baptismal covenant as they Live among God's faithful people; Hear the word of God and share in the Lord's Supper;

Proclaim the good news of God through word and deed; Serve all people following the example of Jesus; and Strive for justice and peace in all the world. The culmination of the Emerge experience is to write a faith statement and assemble a story board that is displayed on Confirmation Sunday.



BackPack Buddies Update

Thank you for your amazing response to our special fall offering for the Backpack Buddies ministry!! Because of your generosity, our offering total for August and September was \$4,455. When combined with the special \$2,000 matching gift from the St. Stephen Trust Fund, this means our offering total was \$6,455.

Programs like ours fill a critical key need for students at Olmsted Elementary School who do not get enough to eat when they don't have access to free or reduced-fee lunches. Studies have shown that the positive impacts of backpack feeding programs can include improved academic performance and attendance, as well as helping low-income families become food secure.

St. Stephen has learned a lot since we launched this version of our backpack ministry during the pandemic. As we put those lessons to work, we're exploring new partnerships and resources to purchase food more efficiently and economically. This will reduce the weekly cost to feed each



student and ensure the sustainability of the program for the long term.
